About XING

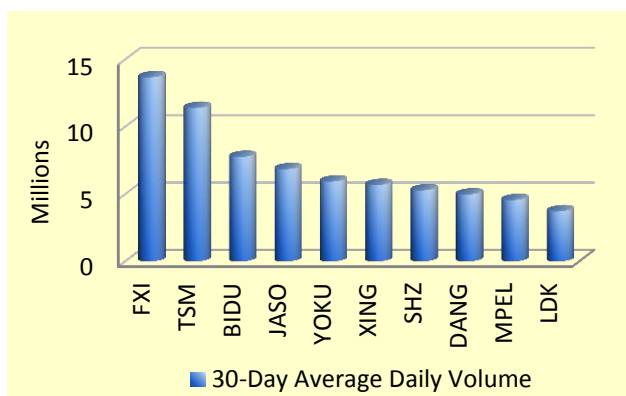
