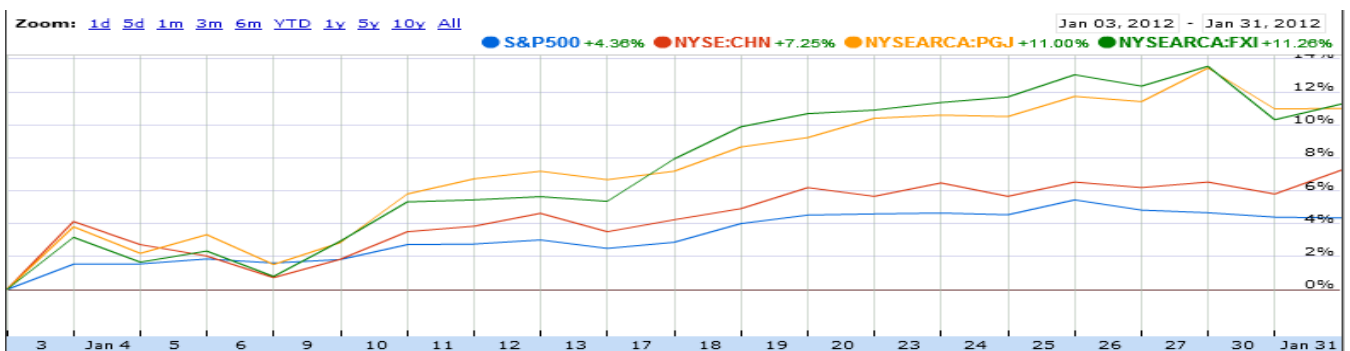

About CSUN

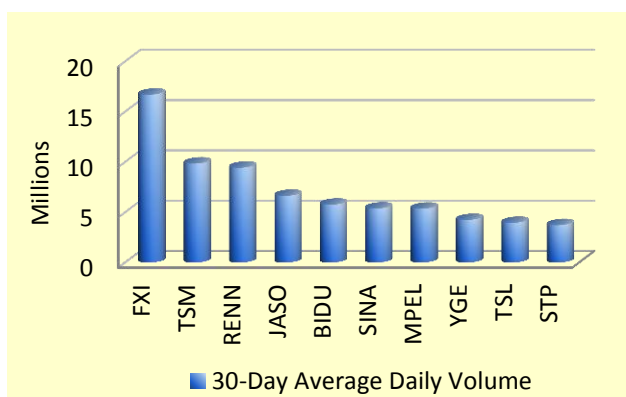
